Media Statement - Impersonation of Justice M Madlanga: Justice of the Constitutional

Court

On Wednesday, 29 May 2024, an unknown person whose WhatsApp page reflects his name

as Justice Mbuyiselo Madlanga sent a text message to a senior official of the Electoral

Commission. The text message, sent from cell phone number 072 691 1537, was clearly an

attempt to impersonate Constitutional Court Justice, Justice Mbuyiseli Madlanga.

The Office of the Chief Justice (OCJ) wishes to place it on record that this text message did

not come from Justice Madlanga. Justice Madlanga is grateful to the Electoral Commission

for alerting him to this impersonation.

Earlier on the same day, 29 May 2024, a text purporting to have been sent by Justice

Madlanga from the same number was received by an official of the South African Broadcasting

Corporation (SABC). The sender was asking for a contact number of a former senior official

of the SABC. This text was also not sent by Justice Madlanga.

On 19 August 2023, the OCJ issued a media statement concerning the impersonation of

Justice Madlanga where cell phone number 063 204 2566 was used. Several other Judges

have been impersonated on various occasions over a long period of time. The OCJ alerted

the relevant authorities so that this unseemly behaviour may be brought to a stop and the

culprit or culprits brought to book.
